"Every day there is a moment where I pinch myself," said Jenn Feldman, an LA-based interior designer. "I still can't believe this is my family home!" The stunning 4-bedroom property in West Los Angeles underwent a year-long transformation to bring new life to this historical gem. Jenn collaborated with architect Scott Alan Joyce to restore and update the 1935 Colonial Revival home, including this stunning dining room makeover.

OLD-HOME CHARM

First, Jenn tackled the flow and function of the space. In addition to updating electrical, she raised heights of hallways and reconfigured rooms to suit her family's modern lifestyle. A master woodworker transformed a built-in cabinet in the dining room. He crafted a door with hidden hinges and matched the paneling exactly to the original wainscoting. This also allowed the wallcovering to seamlessly extend along the wall.
